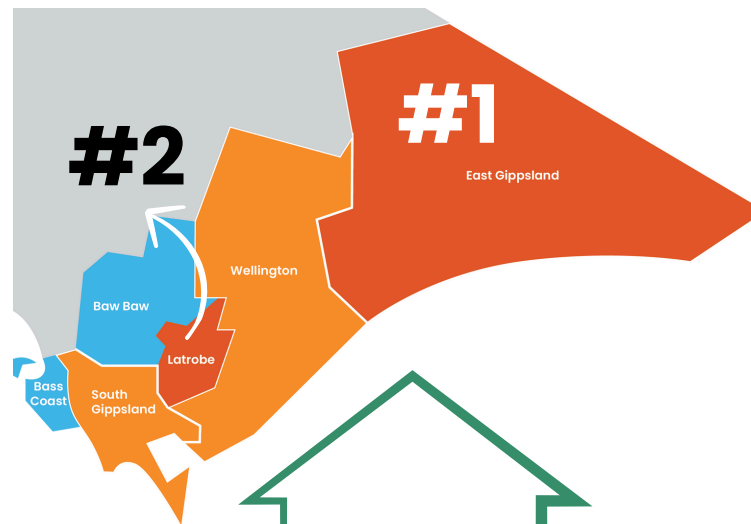

To address Gippsland's high rates of family violence – including the systemic impacts on the community – **we are asking for investment into:**

- Services for Men
- Case management
- Therapeutic Supports
- Housing and exit pathways



3,512 of Gippsland people received a **Homelessness service** because of family violence.

73.4% of people seeking assistance for family violence identified as female



21%

of family violence incidents had a child present



East Gippsland and Latrobe are #1 and #2 in the state per 100,000 population for family violence. All six (6) Gippsland Local Government Areas (LGAs) are in the **top 30** out of 79 Victorian LGAs.
